Title: Tree rings as a multi-proxy record of past tropical cyclone activity

Abstract:

Tropical cyclones are one of the most dangerous natural hazards and they are undergoing dramatic changes in their intensity and trajectories. Surprisingly, long-term trends in tropical cyclone activity are poorly understood owing to discrepancies among various datasets and limited span of instrumental records. In my talk, I will provide a short overview of our past, current and future treering based research of tropical cyclone activity in East Asia.
